USE: For control of fungi, decay, molds, and sapstain on wood. Suitable for all wood items including fences, millwork, siding and shingles, furniture, greenhouse items, fruit and vegetable bins, construction lumber and playground equipment.

DIRECTIONS: Apply liberally by brush or spray to bare wood free of previous coatings. For best results, dip. Immersion is recommended -- 3 minutes for above ground use.

PAINTING: Treated wood should be dried for 1-2 hours before application of a water based paint and for 24-48 hours prior to use of an oil based paint or varnish.

COVERAGE: Varies with porosity of the wood. Generally, coverage is about 200 sq. ft. per gallon for brush or spray and 100 sq. ft. per gallon for dip application.
