FOR TREATMENT BY DIP, ROLLER, BRUSH, AND SPRAYING

The best results will be obtained if wood to be treated is immersed for 3 minutes or longer. If dipping is not possible, 2 liberal—coats by brush, roller, or spray applications should be applied. Allow at least 1 hour between applications. Make certain all areas are fully treated to get the maximum benefits. Allow 24 hours or longer after application of the preservative prior to painting.

COVERAGE: One gallon covers 100 - 300 sq. ft, depending upon the wood species, porosity of the wood, and method of appliation.

RECOMMENDED FOR

Windows, window frames, doors, stairs, porches, shingles, steps, interior trim, wall paneling, furniture, fence pickets, fence rails, furring strips, flooring and beverage cases. Powder post beetles which invade furniture, flooring and structural lumber are killed by application of this preservative. These insects will not attack the treated wood.
