The best results will be obtained if wood to be treated is immersed for 3 minutes or longer. If dipping is not possible, 2 liberal brush or spray applications should be applied. Allow at least one hour between applications. Make certain all areas are fully treated to get the maximum benefits. Allow 24 hours or longer after application of the preservative prior to painting. Less paint is needed over wood treated with this water repellent wood preservative.

**RECOMMENDED USES**

Windows, window frames, doors, stairs, porches, shingles, trellises, steps, subflooring, interior, trim, wall, paneling, furniture, fence pickets, fence rails, furring strips, arbors, flooring and beverage cases.

In addition to preventing decay and blue stain on wood, this preservative inhibits warping, swelling, shrinking and end checking caused by changes in moisture content of lumber and plywood products.
