The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Place an "*" after "Inert Ingredients" and then add "*" Contains xylene" under the ingredients statement.
2. Update the Environmental Hazards Statement by changing "by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes" to "when disposing of equipment washwaters."
3. The If In Eyes statement should read "Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately."

Based on the current Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated 5/8/89, your product will not meet the label claim for the active ingredient. Please revise the CSF to reflect that the lower certified limit of lindane is the same as the label claim.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
