PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin. Causes severe eye irritation. Causes dermatitis. Do not get in eyes. Do not get on clothing. Do not breathe vapor. Examples of acceptable materials for protective clothing (e.g., gloves, overalls, jackets, and boots) required during application and handling of pentachlorophenol are polyvinyl acetate (PVA), polyvinyl chloride (PVC), neoprene, NBR (Buna N), and nitrile.
