Permatox IPB should be diluted with water before use. Mix 1 part Permatox IPB with 10 parts water which has been warmed to 100°F. Vigorous stirring is necessary during the dilution. Permatox IPB emulsions tend to separate if rest is allowed. Stir gently without agitation. Thorough mixing and use is always the best.

The finished material must be protected from weather.

The best results will be obtained if wood to be treated is immersed for 3 minutes or longer. If dipping is not possible, use liberal brush or spray application. Allow to dry before reapplying. Allow at least 1 day between applications. Make certain all areas are completely treated to get the maximum benefits. Allow to dry longer after application of the preservative prior to painting. Less paint is required on wood treated with this water repellent preservative.

#### RECOMMENDED USES

Use on exterior trim, doors, stairs, porches, decks, and exterior flooring, interior trim, wall paneling, fence pickets, fence rails, furniture, and beverage cases.

Prevents rotting decay and blue stain on exterior wood. It inhibits warping, swelling, cracking, and checking caused by changes in moisture content of lumber and plywood.

Permatox IPB is recommended for wood to be painted with oil or latex.
