Permatox IPB must be diluted with water for use. Dilute 1 part Permatox IPB with 100 parts water which has been warmed to 100°F. Vigorous agitation is necessary during the dilution process. Permatox IPB emulsions tend to separate for long periods without agitation. Vigorous mixing before using is always necessary.

The diluted concentrate must be protected from freezing.

The best results will be obtained if wood to be treated is immersed for 3 minutes or longer. If immersion is not possible, 2 liberal brush applications should be applied. Allow 24 hours between applications. Make certain all areas are fully treated to get the maximum benefit. Allow 24 hours or longer after application of the preservative prior to painting. Less than 2 applications are needed over wood treated with the repellent wood preservative.

## RECOMMENDED USE

Windows, window frames, doors, stairs, shingles, steps, subflooring, interior wall paneling, furniture, fence pickets, fence corner strips, flooring and beverage cases. In addition to preventing decay and bluing, this preservative inhibits warping, shrinking, and end checking caused by uneven moisture content of lumber and wood products.

Permatox IPB is not recommended for use in contact with soil.
