This following labeling, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments.

Update First Aid Statement per PR Notice 2001-1

Label Comment

1. The precautionary statement and subheading must be revised to read as follows.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT HAZARD TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER

Corrosive. Causes eye damage or skin burns. Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Harmful if swallowed. Wear goggles or face shield (safety glasses). Wear protective clothing (long-sleeve shirt and long pants, socks plus shoes and chemical-resistant gloves such as water proof gloves). Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

2. Add the following statement at the beginning of the environmental hazards statement:

"This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisims."

For the control of sapstain and mold on green or freshly cut lumber, STA BRITE C is generally effective when used as a 15 second dip at a concentration of 2 fluid ounces per gallon of water. For severe conditions of ambient temperature and humidity, STA BRITE C may be used at up to 4 fluid ounces per gallon of water in a dip tank or spray application so as to uniformly wet all surfaces of the wood. Green wood should be treated within twenty-four hours of cutting or sawing.

In order to insure best results, the dipping tank must be protected from rain. The treated lumber should not be allowed to remain unprotected in heavy rains, especially just after treatment. Lumber piles should be roofed and adequate space should be left between boards and stacks. Green lumber should not be used for stickers.
