## WOOD TREATMENT

**Green Peeled Posts:** To prevent fungus decay and/or rot, prepare a solution of 18.0 pounds of sodium chromate in each 24 gallons of water to be used and a separate second solution of 18.0 pounds of copper sulfate in each 24 gallons of water to be used. Soak the peeled green posts butt-end down first, in the copper sulfate solution for 3 days; then butt-end down in the sodium chromate solution for 2 days, and finally turn the posts upside down in the sodium chromate solution for 1 additional day. Remove and rinse the posts with clear water.
