WARNING

PRESSURE TREATING WOOD

BUFFALO SYSTEM II, when used in conjunction with either DCD Copper Complex or DCD Copper Sulfate in dual pressure treatments yielding copper retentions of 0.05 to 0.20 pounds per cubic foot of wood, will prevent attack from wood-destroying insects (including termites), decay fungi and mildew. Treated wood may typically be used for decks, buildings, fences, poles, etc.

BUFFALO SYSTEM II is used with a pressure procedure to treat sapwood to achieve retention levels of 0.24 to 0.96 lbs. per cu. ft. of copper dimethyldithiocarbamate (CuDDC).

BUFFALO SYSTEM II should be diluted with water as needed to achieve the correct concentration for sapwood penetration and retention.

If desired, compatible fire-retardant salts can be added to the treating solution to produce fire-retarding wood.

Maintain a pH of at least 9.0 during all phases of treatment. Do not allow the solution pH to drop below 7.0 because undesirable decomposition products may develop.

Do not enter treatment cylinder after treatment until cylinder has been purged with air. Alternatively, a face mask with separate air supply may be used.

BUFFALO SYSTEM II treatments should be done only in conjunction with dual treatments using an EPA-approved, copper-based wood preservative such as DCD Copper Complex or DCD Copper Sulfate, which are registered by IBC Manufacturing Company.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: Store in a secure, well-ventilated area protected from extreme temperatures. Do not transfer to unmarked containers. Keep container closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
