DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use water collected from treated wood for potable water.

Premier is a liquid concentrate of 3-Iodo-2-Propynyl Butyl Carbamate (IPBC) and 1-[[2-(2,4-dichlorophenyl)-4-propyl-1,3-dioxolan-2-yl]-methyl]-1H-1,2,4-triazole (Propiconazole) which readily mixes with various diluents to form a preservative solution.

Wood products for use in particle board and veneer production processes may be protected from sapstain and mold by the same treating processes recommended for freshly cut lumber and timber.

FOR STAIN AND MOLD CONTROL ON FRESHLY CUT LUMBER, TIMBERS, AND PEELED LOGS: Freshly cut wood should be treated within 24 hours. Otherwise, fungal attack may extend below the surface of the wood beyond the reach of a surface fungicide treatment. Freshly treated lumber should be protected from rain.

The longer the time between falling the log and sawn lumber production, the greater the incidence of pre-infection and the lower the level of stain and mold control will be achieved. This is particularly true of lumber from susceptible tree species such as pine, fir, hemlock, and yellow poplar.

Dip Tank and Across-the-Chain Applications:

The most cost effective strength of a Tuff Brite II solution will depend on the environment, the lumber treated, and the duration of control required.

Under **mild** stain and mold conditions, dilutions of 1 gallon of Tuff Brite II to 150 - 200 gallons of dip vat solution are recommended.

Under moderate stain and mold conditions, dilutions of 1 gallon of Premier with 100 to 125 gallons of dip vat solution are recommended.

Under severe stain and mold conditions, a dilution of 1 gallon of Premier to 50 to 75 gallons of dip vat solution are recommended.

Low Volume Spray Application:

For individual boards which are treated in low volume spray machines, add 1 gallon of Premier to 15-50 gallons of water. Smooth surfaced lumber normally retains only about one-half as much fungicide solution as rough cut wood and, therefore, needs the higher rate to deposit the necessary amount of fungicide on the wood.

(Directions for Use Continued)

Addition of a corrosion inhibitor is not required with Premier, as the formulation contains a built-in corrosion-inhibiting system.
