Acti-dione PM is a fungicide which controls powdery mildew and rust on roses and powdery mildew on phlox, zinnias, chrysanthemums, tuberous begonias, euonymus, honeysuckle, crape myrtle, and deciduous magnolias. Acti-dione PM will prevent infection by the fungi which cause rust and mildew, and will also eradicate established infections of powdery mildew. Acti-dione PM does not leave an unsightly residue on the foliage.

Package contains full net weight. Head space is necessary to allow accurate filling and avoid spilling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

When to Apply

The first spray should be applied when mildew or rust appear, or a series of protective sprays can be started early in the season before the development of rust or mildew. Sprays should be repeated as necessary, normally every 7 days, or every 3 to 5 days if disease is severe.

How Much to Use

Reses (except ramblers)—Use 2 level tablespoonfuls of Acti-dians PM say salten of water. When Acti-c'ene PM is mined with other pesticides as a procative spray for roses (before mildew and rust appear), use 1 tablespoonful of Acti-dione PM per gallon of water. Rambler reses and other ernamentals—Use 5 level tablespoonfuls of Acti-dione PM per gallor of water.

How to Apply

Add Acti-dione PM slowly to water in pressure splay tank or hose-on sprayer bottle while stirting. When mixing with other chemicals, first add Acti-dione . M to water and then add the other materials. Uniformly spray leaves and stems until they are thoroughly wet. For best results, spray on bright sunny days Prepare fresh spray mixture daily.

Note: The amount of water to be added is pased on U.S. Measure. Five (5) U.S. gallons are equal to annoximately four (4) Imperial gallons.

Acti-dione PM may be applied with most of the commonly used insecticides and fungicides used on roses and other ornamentals. However, until the compatibility is established under local conditions, it is suggested that mixtures of Acti-dione PM and other pesticides be tried on a limited area or number of plants. Do not mix Actidione PM with chlordane or alkaline materials such as lime.
