GENERAL INFORMATION

Acti-dione PM is a fungicide which controls powdery mildew and rust on roses and powdery mildew on philox. zinnias, chrysanthemums, tuberous begonias, euonymus, honeysuckle, crape myrtle, and deciduous magnolias. Acti-dione PM will prevent infection by the fungi which cause rust and mildew, and will also eradicate established infections of powdery mildew. Acti-dione PM does not leave an unsightly residue on the foliage.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When to Apply

The first spray should be applied when mildew or rust appear, or a series of protective sprays can be started early in the season before the development of rust or mildew. Sprays should be repeated as necessary, normally every 7 days, or every 3 to 5 days if disease is severe.

How Much to Use

Roses (except ramblers)—Use at the rate of 1 ounce of Acti-dione PM per 2 gallons of water or 3 lb 2 1/2 oz per 100 gallons of water. For mixing with other pesticides as a protective spray, use at the rate of 1 ounce per 4 gallons of water or 1 lb 9 oz per 100 gallons of water.

Rambler roses and other ornamentals—Use at the rate of 1 ounce of Acti-dione PM per gallon of water or 6 lb 4 oz per 100 gallons of water.

How to Apply

Add Acti-dione PM slowly to water while stirring. When mixing with other chemicals, first add Acti-dione PM to water and then add the other materials. Uniformly spray leaves and stems until they are thoroughly wet. For best results, spray on bright sunny days. Prepare fresh spray mixture daily.

COMPATIBILITY

Acti-dione PM may be applied with most of the commonly used insecticides and fungicides for roses and other ornamentals. However, until the compatibility is established under local conditions, it is suggested that mixtures of Acti-dione PM and other pesticides be tried on a limited area or number of plants. Do not mix Acti-dione PM with chloroform or alkaline materials such as lime.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container and keep closed. Store in a cool dry place.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.
