DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TURF: Apply the recommended amounts of Acti-dione TGF/Daconil combination in sufficient water to obtain thorough coverage (3 to 5 gallons/1000 sq.ft. on greens and tees or 30 to 50 gallons/acre on fairways) for the control of Copperspot, Curvalaria leafspot, Dollarspot, Gray leafspot, *Helminthosporium* leafspot, melting-out, fading-out, Large brown patch, Red thread, rusts, and powdery mildew.

Before using Acti-dione TGF and Daconil read and observe all cautionary statements, conditions, warranties, and all other information appearing on both labels.

This supplemental label contains new or supplemental instructions for use of these products which may not appear on the package labels.

RECOMMENDED RATES FOR ACTI-DIONE TGF/DACONIL TANK MIXTURE

Combine Acti-dione TGF with either:

Fairways	0.34 ounces/ 1000 sq.ft. 15 oz/Acre	0.92 ounces/ 1000 sq.ft. 2.5 lbs/Acre	1.5 fluid ounces/ 1000 sq.ft. 2.0 Qts/Acre	Apply Acti-dione TGF/Daconil combination at 14 to 21 day intervals immediately following first mowing in the spring and continue until after last mowing in late fall. Severe conditions may require a shortened interval of 10 to 14 days.
Greens and Tees	1.0 ounce/ 1000 sq.ft.	1.0 ounce/ 1000 sq.ft.	2.5 fluid ounces/ 1000 sq.ft.	Apply Acti-dione TGF/Daconil combination at 7 to 10 day intervals. Under hot, humid weather conditions that favor fungus disease development it may be necessary to shorten the application interval to 5 to 7 days.
