	4		For best results, mow the turf and rake dead grass from damaged spots; water the turf and allow to dry before spraying. Do not water again until necessary. Apply Proxol 80 SP when insect population reach levels sufficient to warrant control measures.
White grubs	1,000 sq.ft.	3 3/4 oz.	Mix specified amount of Proxol 80 S in 15 to 30 gallons of water and apply uniformly to 1,000 sq.ft. of turf. Thoroughly irrigate turf immediately after application.

The new reduced rate of 1 1/2 ozs. Proxol 80 SP has been tested and found to be effective in controlling cutworms, sod webworms and armyworms. When severe, high population outbreaks occur the maximum suggested rates are applicable.

The new 1 1/2 ounce recommendation offers the following advantages:

- 1. Flexibility that enables dosage to be adjusted according to insect pressures.
