Seed Silk 333 contains the new Diazinon MG 50 and graphite in a 2 to 1 ratio. The graphite is selected for compatibility and lubricating properties to assist in accurate planting. Diazinon is effective in protecting germinating seeds and young seedlings against seed corn beetles and seed corn maggots.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Keep plates clean. Grease or oil on plates can cause clogging.

Planter Box Application: Mix recommended amounts of SEED SILK 333 into seed with a mixing stick or in a rotating mixer such as a cement mixer. Best protection is obtained when every seed is coated with the chemical.

For Seed Corn Beetles: Mix in 4½ ounces (4½ rounded scoops) of Seed Silk 333 per bushel of seed corn as a dry mixture prior to planting.

For Seed Corn Maggots: Mix 3 ounces (3 rounded scoops) of Seed Silk 333 per bushel of seed prior to planting.

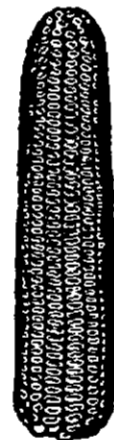
Note. Use only on seed that has previously been treated with a fungicide, BUT do not mix Seed Silk 333 with any other Pesticide.
