DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON CORN

For the control of European Corn Borer, use AIDEX 10% Sevin Granules at the rate of 15 to 20 pounds per acre by aircraft or ground equipment. More than one application may be necessary. Do not apply within seven days of harvest.
