May be fatal if swallowed.
Do not breathe vapors. Do not get on skin or in eyes or on clothing. Can be absorbed through skin in dry form or in solution. Keep clothing free from residue. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs.

Toxic to fish, wildlife and birds. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Do not reuse drum for anything other than toxaphene formulation. Otherwise, return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place away from water supplies.

Antidote: Internal - Give sodium chloride 15 g. (one tablespoonful of table salt) in glass of warm water and repeat until vomit is clear. Call a Physician.
External - Wash with soap and water.

For 5% Toxaphene, mix 1 gallon of Toxaphene-6S with 15 gallons of oil.
