Apply SHIELD to animal, rubbing against the grain of the hair. Give particular attention to the shanks, legs and face, being careful not to get the material in the eyes. Then groom with a brush.

Protection can be obtained initially by depositing 1 to 2 oz. of SHIELD on the animal, depending on size. Subsequent applications may require less due to a build-up of repellency from previous applications. Apply daily or as needed.

The wiping cloth can be kept in a container or plastic bag for reuse.

The amount of SHIELD necessary for good results will depend on various factors such as weather conditions and severity of insects.

### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid using excessive amounts on the animal. Do not wet the hide. Do not store or pour near open flame.

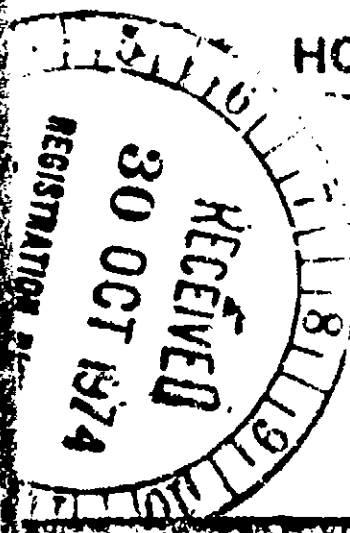
