### GIFT VELENO VENENO

#### FIRST AID - ANTIDOTE

**INTERNAL:** Give sodium chloride 15 g. (one tablespoonful of table salt) in glass of warm water and repeat until vomit is clear.

**EXTERNAL:** Wash with soap and water.

**CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY**

**PHYSICIAN'S NOTE:** Toxaphene produces central nervous system excitation which responds to barbituric acid derivatives. Prevent or control convulsions with barbiturates, preferably administered intravenously. If the barbiturate can be given before convulsions start, sodium pentobarbital is the drug of choice. Since toxaphene has a fairly long duration of action, a long-acting barbiturate such as phenobarbital may be used after initial control of convulsions. Refer to "Clinical Handbook on Economic Poisons," which was prepared by the U. S. Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, Public Health Service, Communicable Disease Center, Atlanta, Georgia.
