

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ALL ALFA and CLOVER:

For control of alfalfa weevil, spittlebug, leafhopper and aphid. First cutting: Apply 2 to 3 quarts in 20-25 gallons water per acre as soon as weevil damage appears in the field. Early application is desired to control the weevil when they are small. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not apply after full bloom.

STUBBLE SPRAYING:

In areas where weevil appears at cutting time, remove the first cutting and apply 2 to 3 quarts in 20-25 gallons water per acre to the stubble to control weevil larvae and aphids. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

SECOND AND SUBSEQUENT CUTTINGS:

Apply 2 to 3 quarts in 20-25 gallons of water per acre to control alfalfa weevil, leafhopper and aphids as these insects appear. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

AIRPLANE APPLICATION:

The above directions are for ground application. For airplane application use 2 to 3 quarts in 3 to 10 gallons water per acre.
