**Precautionary Statements
Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals:**

DANGER

Corrosive to tissues. This concentrate causes eye and skin damage. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of food. Do not use, pour, spill or store near fire or open flame.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available drink large quantities of water and call a physician immediately. **Note to Physician:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Disinfecting Washable Hard Surfaces: This product is a concentrate and must be diluted for use. A 1/2% solution (1/2 ounce per gallon of water) is recommended for all disinfecting applications. Apply by wiping, mopping, spraying with a coarse spray or scrubbing to wet surfaces thoroughly with the use solution. Pre-clean and rinse all heavily soiled surfaces before disinfection.

When cleaning and disinfecting animal, poultry or veterinary facilities, first remove all livestock from the premises, cover or remove all feed and food stuffs, and remove all dirt, litter and debris. Then thoroughly saturate all pre-cleaned surfaces with use solution. (Wash all feeders and waterers with a detergent, then rinse with potable water before reuse.) Allow disinfected surfaces to dry before rehousing livestock. This is a complete product. Use only as directed. Do not add other chemicals.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
