PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals

Read carefully the following statement which applies to the contents of this container.

DANGER: Causes eye and skin damage. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of food.

FOR USE ON ALL WASHABLE HARD ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES INCLUDING TUBERCULOUS AREAS, USE A 1:128 SOLUTION.

Vestal Eight H contains no added phosphates and must be diluted for use. It forms an effective solution with both hard and soft waters. Apply solutions with normal techniques using sponge, mop, or cloth by wiping, mopping or scrubbing to wet surfaces thoroughly. Treated surfaces should remain wet for 10 minutes. Remove excess solution with a wrung-out applicator. Discard solution when soiled, and replace with a fresh solution. Always remove gross filth or heavy soil before applying the solutions of this product. Heavily soiled surfaces should be precleaned and rinsed before applying a Vestal Eight H solution. This is a complete product. Do not add other chemicals. Use only as directed.

A 1:128 DILUTION OF THIS PRODUCT IS GERMICIDAL, PSEUDOMONACIDAL, TUBERCULOCIDAL AND FUNGICIDAL BY OFFICIAL A.O.A.C. QUALIFICATIONS IN 400PPM HARD WATER (A.O.A.C. 400 PPM AS CaCO₃) IN 10 MINUTES AT 20°C.

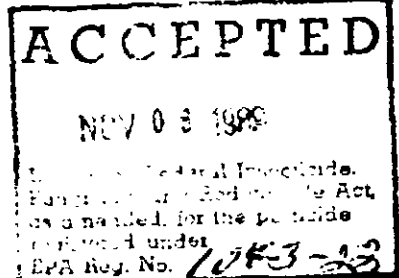

FUNGICIDAL TEST (A.O.A.C. T. mentagrophytes) effective in 10 minutes at 20°C when diluted 1:128 in 400ppm Hard Water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
