### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Prepare 1/2% solution according to the following table

To Make	Use Vestal 10 Concentrate
1 quart	1 tsp.
1 gallon	2/3 fl. oz.
5 gallons	3 1/3 fl. oz.

Where surfaces or instruments are heavily soiled, solution strength may be increased to 1% or even 2% to improve detergency.

When used as directed VESTAL 10 is harmless to fabrics, resilient flooring, tile, terrazzo, painted and varnished surfaces.

**CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid prolonged skin contact and avoid splashing in eyes. Wash eyes with large amounts of flowing water if exposed. For eyes get medical attention. Avoid contamination of food.
