T.B.Q. is a concentrated multipurpose germicidal detergent. When diluted as directed, even with hard water it is an excellent disinfectant. It is also effective against many pathogenic bacteria and fungi including *S. aureus*, *P. aeruginosa*, *M. tuberculosis*, and *Candida albicans* on washable hard surfaces.

T.B.Q. is recommended for cleaning and disinfection of washable hard surfaces such as floors and walls in hospitals, schools, nursing homes, restaurants, and industrial plants, food preparation and service facilities, and other public areas. T.B.Q. simultaneously cleans, deodorizes, and disinfects. Use solutions made as directed are not harmful to fabrics, carpet flooring, tile, painted or varnished surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Cleaning and Disinfecting Hard Surfaces—Dilute 1:64 with water and apply by normal methods with cloth, sponge, mop or spray equipment.

Cleaning and Disinfecting Thermometers—Preclean thermometers and soak in 1:64 solution for a minimum of 10 minutes.

Cleaning and Disinfecting Food Handling Surfaces—Dilute 1:64 with water and apply by normal methods. Protect or remove food during application. Rinse with potable water before reuse.

USE DILUTION TABLE

Quantity of T.B.Q. concentrate to make recommended 1:64 use solutions:

Water	5 liters	20 liters	1 gallon	5 gallons
T.B.Q.	78 cc	312 cc	2 fl. oz.	10 fl. oz.

"T.B.Q." is a complete product. Do not add other chemicals. Use only as directed.

DANGER: Corrosive to tissues. This concentrate causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Do not reuse container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

FIRST AID: In case of contact flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed drink large quantities of fluid—egg white, gelatin solution or water; call a physician. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting.

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.



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
