When diluted as directed, even with hard water, it is an excellent cleaner, and is biocidally effective against many pathogenic bacteria and fungi including *S. aureus*, *S. choleraesuis*, *Ps. aeruginosa*, *M. tuberculosis*, and *T. mentagrophytes* on washable hard surface.

T.B.Q. is recommended for cleaning and disinfection of washable hard surfaces such as floors and walls in hospitals, schools, nursing homes, restaurants, industrial plants, food preparation and service facilities, and other public areas. T.B.Q. simultaneously cleans, deodorizes, and disinfects. Use solutions made as directed are not harmful to fabrics, resilient flooring, tile, painted or varnished surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Cleaning and Disinfecting Hard Surfaces: Dilute T.B.Q. with water and apply by normal methods with cloth, sponge, mop, or spray equipment.

Cleaning and Disinfecting Thermometers: Pre-clean thermometers and immerse in T.B.Q. solution for a minimum of 10 minutes.

Cleaning and Disinfecting Food Handling Surfaces: Dilute T.B.Q. with water and apply by normal methods. Protect or remove food during application. Rinse with potable water before reuse.

Critical Care Areas, Heavily Soiled Surfaces, Dainties with Hard Water, or Veterinary Activity: Dilute 1:64 (2 oz./gallon) and apply as directed above.

T.B.Q. is a complete product. Do not add other chemicals. Use only as directed.

DANGER: Corrosive to tissues. This concentrate causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

FIRST AID: In case of contact flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed drink large quantities of fluid—egg white, gelatin solution or water; call a physician. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting.

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Cleaning and Disinfecting Hard Surfaces. Dilute 1:16 normal methods with cloth, sponge, mop, or spray. For Cleaning and Disinfecting Thermometers, use a special solution for a minimum of 10 minutes.

Cleaning and Disinfecting Food Handling Surfaces. Normal methods. Protect or remove food during application.

Critical Care Areas, Heavily Soiled Surfaces. Dilutions 1:64 (2 oz./gallon) and apply as directed above.

T.B.Q. is a caustic product. Do not add other chemicals.

DANGER: Corrosive to tissues. This concentrate causes skin or on clothing. Wear goggles and rubber gloves. Avoid contamination of food. Do not use, pour, spill.

FIRST AID: In case of contact flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. In case of contact with eyes, remove contact lenses if possible and continue flushing. If swallowed, induce vomiting. If inhaled, get fresh air.
