## **VESTAL V-400**

**Bacterial Growth Inhibitor for Natural Cutting Oils** 

Vestal V-400, when used as directed as an additive to aqueous dilutions of natural alkaline cutting oil emulsions, reduces corrosion and inhibits bacterial growth for extended cutting oil life.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

INITIAL TREATMENT OF FOULED COOL NT SYSTEM AND NEW OIL CHANGE: For optimum results, drain and thoroughly clean cutting oil sump and distribution system with a hot detergent solution followed by complete rinsing. Add one part V-400 to each 400 parts of diluted and ready-to-use cutting oil emulsion (1/3 ounce per gallon of pre-diluted cutting oil solution). Mix thoroughly. V-400 has been shown to be effective in a cutting oil to water ratio of 1:50.

SUBSEQUENT MAINTENANCE TREATMENT OF OIL: Treat during addition of make-up oil if needed to maintain control as determined by organoleptic inspection of each system and evidence of bacterial growth and malodors. The concentration of V-400 in a system may be increased to 1:128 (one ounce per gallon of total solution) if indicated by daily organoleptic inspection.

Read carefully the following statement which applies to the contents of this container. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame. Use only as directed.

DANGER: Extremely corrosive to eyes and skin. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Do not reuse empty container; rinse thoroughly with water and discard.

Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Treated water should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams ponds or public water. Use this product only as specified on this label.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. For eyes call physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, geletin solution, or if these are not available drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.
