DIRECTIONS FOR USE

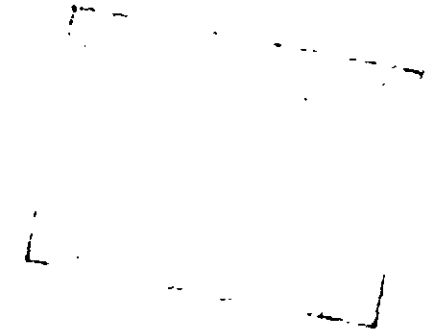

Statements

PREPARATION BEFORE USE

FOR USE IN HARD WATER USE TWO TABLETS PER GALLON OF WATER

1. Measure 1/2 gallon of water into a clean container.

3. Stir the water until the tablets are completely dissolved.
