

**DIRECTION FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply QUAT-64 to floors, walls and other hard surfaces such as tables, chairs, and bedframes with a cloth or mop. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning may be required.

At two ounces per gallon use level, QUAT 64 is effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, and *Trichophyton Interdigitale*. Germicidal performance against the first three organisms has been confirmed by the AOAC Use Dilution Test.

*At two ounces per gallon use level, QUAT 64 is virucidal against Herpes Simplex (a member of the virus family that causes infectious mononucleosis), Vaccinia (representative of the pox viruses) and Influenza A, (the Hong Kong Flu virus) on inanimate environmental surfaces.

Fungicidal performance against *T. Interdigitale* was determined by the AOAC Fungicidal Test.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide, spray mixture or residue that cannot be used or ethically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

3. CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse for equivalent, and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers or bury in a safe place.

4. GENERAL

Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures, such as limited open burning.

DANGER

Cleaning and Disinfecting Washable Hard Non-Porous Surfaces: Add one ounce (30 cc) to each measured gallon of water used. Always add Vestal Insure to premeasured water. Gently mix for a uniform solution. Apply solution by normal methods with brush, cloth, or mop. Thoroughly wet all surfaces to be cleaned, then remove excess solution with a wrung out applicator. Treated surfaces should remain wet for ten minutes. Remove gross filth mechanically by sweeping before cleaning begins. Discard solution when it becomes dirty and replace with fresh solution. Vestal Insure is a complete product. Do not add other chemicals. Use only as directed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

Pesticide Disposal: This germicide, its solutions or rinsings from empty containers should be disposed of in a toilet or service sink served by a sanitary sewer, in a land fill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.
