3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

When used as directed, it is formulated to disinfect inanimate hard surfaces such as walls, sink tops, tables, chairs, telephones, door knobs, light switches, shower stalls, hampers, cabinets, and bed springs.

In addition, Coverage Foaming Disinfectant Cleaner deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, basements, restrooms, and other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

When used as directed, Coverage Foaming Disinfectant Cleaner demonstrates effective disinfection against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis* and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, thus meeting requirements for hospital use. Efficacy tests have demonstrated that Coverage Foaming Disinfectant Cleaner is an effective one-step cleaner-disinfectant in the presence of organic soil (5% blood serum).

The product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi (*T. mentagrophytes*) when used as directed on hard surfaces found in the bathroom, shower stall, and locker room, or other clean hard non-porous surfaces commonly contacted by bare feet.

MOLD AND MILDEWSTAT - Coverage Foaming Disinfectant Cleaner prevents and controls mold and mildew and the odors they cause on hard non-porous inanimate surfaces.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Coverage Foaming Disinfectant Cleaner has been designed specifically for Institutional, Commercial, and Industrial cleaning and disinfecting in Nursing Homes, Hospitals, Offices, Schools, Motels and Hotels, Recreational Facilities and Factories.

DISINFECTION, CLEANING, AND DEODORIZING: To disinfect, clean, and deodorize hard non-porous surfaces such as bathroom tiles, fixtures, shower stalls, walls, sinks and bathtubs, hampers, tables, chairs and counters:

Hold container six to eight inches from surface to be treated and spray area until it is covered with foam. Allow the product to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. No scrubbing is necessary. Wipe off with a clean cloth, mop, or sponge. The product will not leave grit or soap scum. For heavily soiled areas, remove gross soil before treatment.

MILDEWSTAT - To control mold and mildew on hard non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, table tops, spray the surfaces to be treated, making sure to wet completely with foam. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.
