Dear Mr. Sarli,

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below.

- Addition of Directions to Control Witchweed and Broomrape

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Revise the "Animal Husbandry/Animal Research/Poultry Facility and Fogging" directions by stating:

Remove all animals and feed from the premises, vehicles and enclosures. Remove all litter and manure from the floors, walls, and surfaces of facilities transversed or occupied by animals. Empty all troughs, racks, and other feeding and watering appliances. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Saturate surfaces with a use solution of 1/2 oz per gallon water (1:256 dilution) [include applicable fogging information for those specific directions]. Allow surfaces to remain wet for 10 minutes. Immerse all halters, ropes, and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as forks, shovels, and scrapers used for removing litter and manure. Ventilate buildings, vehicles, and other closed spaces. Do not house livestock or employ equipment until treatment has absorbed, set, or dried. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, and waterers with soap or detergent and rinse with potable water before reuse.

2. Revise the "Fogging" directions by deleting the phrase, "either preceding or following regular cleaning and disinfecting procedures." According to label guidance for animal

premises, the area must be cleaned first before disinfection. Therefore, you must state "This product may be used for fogging following cleaning."


- 3. The use of the term, decontaminate, on a public health label is unacceptable; delete the term. Alternatively, you may state, "To prevent the spread of Witchweed/Broomrape on items" and "Standard Preventive procedures."
- 4. On the right panel, you must qualify surfaces, "tile and porcelain," as hard nonporous by stating "glazed tile" and "glazed porcelain."
- 5. Revise the "Fungicide" directions by adding the statements "....at 20oC in areas such as lockers rooms, showers, and bath areas."

General Comments

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed label before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.
