SPIX

A MODERN INSECTICIDE

To destroy flies and mosquitoes in a room, close all windows and doors and direct a fine mistlike spray upward, walking about the room. About two ounces of Spix should be used per thousand cubic feet. Multiplying the length of the room in feet by the height by the width will give the contents in cubic feet. Keep room tightly closed for at least ten minutes, then immediately sweep up all fallen insects.
