NON-SELECTIVE WEED-KILLER

TOTE controls broad-leaved weeds and most annual and perennial grasses for prolonged periods of time. It is intended for use on non crop areas such as drives, walks, gutters and parking lots — for use where no vegetation is wanted at clubs, schools, institutions and factories.

DIRECTIONS

Dilute 1 gallon of Tote in 15 gallons of water for each 1000 square feet. Apply it uniformly in a coarse spray to avert drift. The best time to apply Tote is immediately before or just when plant growth begins.

Water thoroughly after application to help move Tote to the roots, and to speed and extend weed control.

Do not allow Tote to drift, drain or flush onto lawns, shrubs, trees or other desirable vegetation. Do not apply on areas where roots of such vegetation may extend. Keep Tote out of domestic water supplies and irrigation ditches. Avoid contact of Tote with seeds, fertilizers, insecticides and fungicides.

After applying, avoid corrosion of equipment by cleaning thoroughly with a detergent solution. Use the equipment only for Tote, and not for agricultural chemicals such as fertilizers, fungicides and insecticides.

Repeat application if necessary.

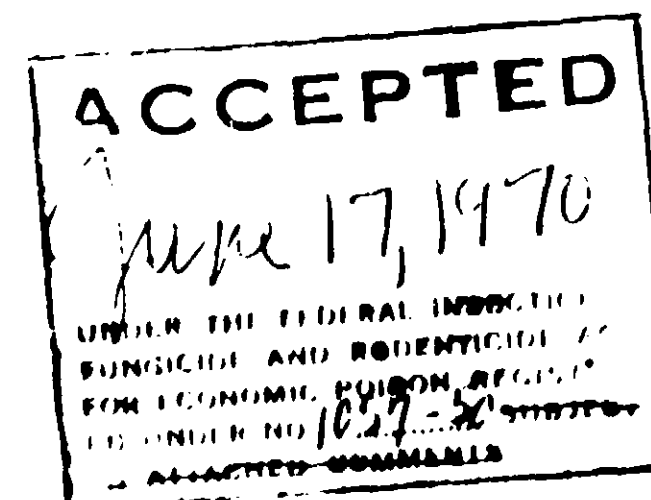

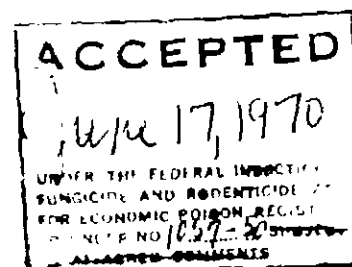
