# MALASOL

**EMULSIFIABLE RESIDUAL INSECTICIDE CONCENTRATE  
DILUTE 1 PART CONCENTRATE WITH 5-7 PARTS WATER**

A surface spray for control of exposed insects such as grain and flour weevils, flour and meal moths, cockroaches, ants, silverfish, spiders, crickets, and carpet beetles. Combines the insect agitating properties of pyrethrins synergized with piperonyl butoxide, and the residual effects of malathion. Use as a wet coarse spray for residual protection in food processing plants, flour mills, grain elevators and empty grain bins. Spray infested areas thoroughly and repeatedly, directing the spray into cracks and other hiding places.

## CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. In case of contact with skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not apply where food other than grain will come in contact. Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

Toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

Do not re-use empty drum. Return to drum conditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.
