DANGER

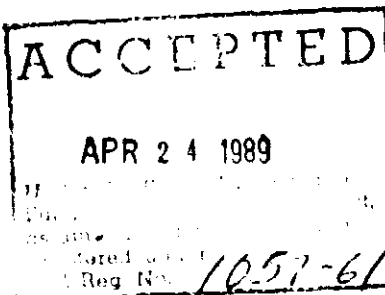

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued)

INDUSTRIAL AND INSTITUTIONAL: For disinfection, such as walls, floors, toilet seats, urinals, garbage receptacles, use one ounce of MINTOL-128 per gallon of water. Always pour water on the disinfectant and stir thoroughly to a uniform milky emulsion.

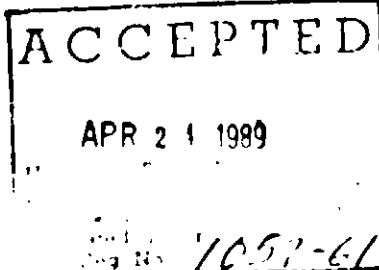
