Dolge Food Plant Fogging Aqueous Pyrethrum Insecticide is a clear, stable, concentrated micro-emulsion. It leaves no oily or objectionable residue. It should be applied with conventional mechanical or compressed air equipment designed and adjusted to deliver a true aerosol mist. It is designed for use in edible product areas of official establishments operating under the Meat, Poultry, Shell Egg Grading and Egg Products Inspection Programs and in other Food Processing Plants.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Do not pour or spill near heat or open flame. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying. Do not breathe spray mist. Refer to the product Material Safety Data Sheet for other safety information.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: Applicators and other handlers must wear:

- Long sleeved shirt and long pants
- Shoes plus socks

IN FOOD PROCESSING ESTABLISHMENTS: The use of this product in food processing establishment should be confined to time periods when the plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment and thoroughly cleaned with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using.

Close windows and doors and shut off ventilating systems. Use a non-thermal fogger or vaporizer adjusted to deliver an aerosol spray (no droplets over 50 microns in diameter and 90% less than 30 microns). Apply at a rate of 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Direct the spray toward the ceiling and upper corners of the area and behind obstructions. Keep the area closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary.

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued from left panel)

IN BARN, POULTRY HOUSES AND STORAGE ROOMS: To control *House Flies*, *Stable Flies* and *Horn Flies* in barns, poultry houses, warehouses, storage bins and storage rooms: dilute 1 part of material with 4 parts of water. Apply as a fine mist over the livestock in stanchions or holding pens. Use a fogger or mist generator to direct spray above the animals and to the center of the area where animals are housed. Apply 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet uniformly throughout the entire area sprayed. Do not ventilate the area for at least 10 minutes after spray has been applied. If used in dairy barns, ventilate the barn thoroughly before milking. Repeat daily in the morning and afternoon, or as required.

The above described application will kill accessible, exposed stages of flies, including *Fruit Flies*, *Mosquitoes*, *Silverfish*, *Flying Moths*, *Gnats*, *Crickets*, *Cockroaches*, *Spiders*, *Scorpions*, *Wasps*, *Homets*, *Clover Mites*, *Cheese Mites*, *Cheese Skippers* and these common stored product pests: *Granary Weevils*, *Rice Weevils*, *Confused Flour Beetles*, *Saw-toothed Grain Beetles*, *Spider Beetles*, *Cigarette Beetles*, *Drug-store Beetles*, *Angoumois Grain Moths*, *Mediterranean Flour Moths*, *Indianmeal Moths*, *Tobacco Moths*, *Meal Moths* and *Grain Mites*.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact users or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR Part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. IN MUSHROOM PRODUCTION AND PROCESSING: To control adult *Mushroom Flies*, *Fungus Gnats* and *Cecid Flies* in growing houses, apply at a rate of 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Fogger should be operated 8 to 10 feet away from beds and directed slightly upward over them. Circulating fans should be left in operation, but for best results refrigeration should be turned off. In packing and canning plants, use at a rate of 1 ounce to 2000 cubic feet of space.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.
