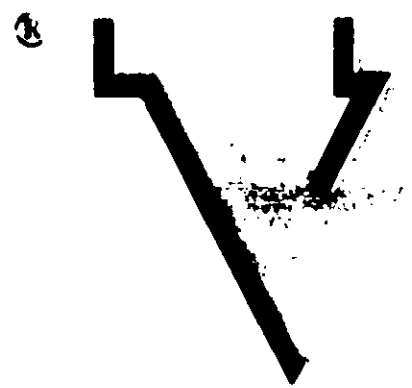

FOR UN-SHELLED OR EARLY BARLEY, SORGHUM, WHEAT AND RYE: BEETLES and MOTHS: FOR GRAIN BEFORE IT GOES INTO STORAGE. FOR GRAIN ALREADY IN STORAGE, MAX. 1/2 GALLON PER TON. DO NOT

FOR BEETLES and MOTHS: FOR GRAIN BEFORE STORAGE. FOR GRAIN IN STORAGE.

FOR CORN, BARLEY, OATS, SORGHUM, RYE and COTTON SEED: BEETLES and

FOR SEEDS: BEETLES and MOTHS

INSECTS CONTROLLED: Confused Flour Beetle, Rice Weevil, Granary Weevil, Saw-toothed Grain Beetle, Flat Grain Beetle, Red Flour Beetle, Rusty Grain Beetle, Lesser Grain Borer, and Indian Meal Moth.

CORN (SHELLED OR EAR), BARLEY, OATS, SORGHUM, WHEAT AND RYE:

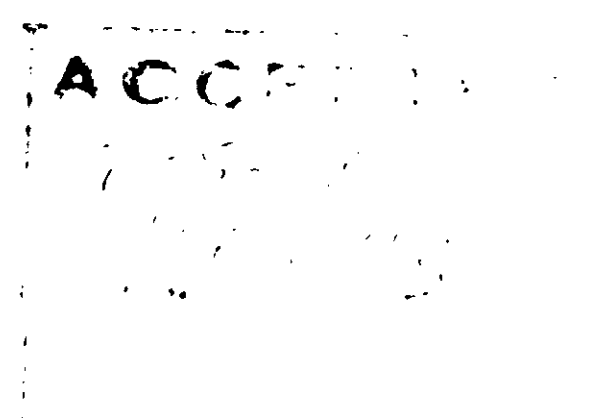
BEETLES and MOTHS: — FOR GRAIN AS GOES INTO STORAGE, mix 1 pint of Malathion Grain Protectant in 2 to 5 gallons of water to treat 1,000 bushels. Spray into grain stream as it goes into storage. **FOR GRAIN ALREADY IN STORAGE,** mix $\frac{1}{2}$ pint Malathion Grain Protectant in 1 to 2 gallons of water to treat 1,000 sq. ft. of grain surface. Will not control insects established beneath the surface. **DO NOT** repeat surface treatment.

RICE (ROUGH): — BEETLES and MOTHS: — FOR GRAIN AS GOES INTO STORAGE, mix 1 pint of Malathion Grain Protectant in 2 to 5 gallons of water to treat 1,000 bushels. Spray into grain stream as it goes into storage. **FOR GRAIN ALREADY IN STORAGE,** mix $\frac{1}{2}$ pint of Malathion Grain Protectant in 1 to 2 gallons of water to treat 1,000 sq. ft. of grain surface. Will not control insects established beneath the surface. **DO NOT** repeat surface treatment.

STORAGE BINS:—For CORN, BARLEY, OATS, SORGHUM, WHEAT, RYE, RICE and COTTON SEED:—BEETLES and MOTHS: Treat storage bins wall and floor 2 to 4 weeks before grain is put into bin. Mix 10 ozs. Malathion Grain Protectant in 2 gallons of water and spray 1,000 sq. feet.

FIELD and GARDEN SEEDS: — BEETLES and MOTHS: Field and garden seeds can be protected against these insects with a dosage of 1 pint Malathion Grain Protectant in 1 to 2 gallons of water and treating 500 bushels of seed. Do not use on food or feed after treating at this rate.

THIS PRODUCT FORMULA PREMIUM GRADE MALATHIONICAL.

CAUTION: Malathion is swallowed or absorbed through the skin in spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with water after using. Avoid use of feed and foodstuffs, food watering troughs. Keep out of children and domestic animal reach. Grain Protectant upon repeated or careless use, may cause inhibition. If poisoning occurs, seek medical aid. Atropine is an antidote where milk is processed. Remove lactating animals from milking. Also remove calves at birth before treating.

CAUTION: — Malathion Grain Protectant is toxic to certain species of fish. Avoid contamination of ponds and streams.

CLEAN UP SPILLAGE AND SPRAY WASTE: Clean up spillage with sawdust or other absorbent material. Clean up area with strong lye solution.

DISPOSAL OF EMPTY CONTAINERS: Completely wash the outside of the empty container with water. Rinse out the inside of the container with water which has been added household or commercial caustic soda (lye). Carefully discard the rinse water by burying at least 18 inches deep in an isolated area away from water supplies. Fifty-five gallon drums may be broken, mutilated and punctured, and may be buried at least 18 inches deep in a hole away from water supplies.

BARLEY, OATS, SORGHUM, COTTON SEED: — **BEETLES and MOTHS:** — Mix 10 ozs. Malathion Grain Protectant in 1 to 2 gal 500 bushels of seed. Do not use at this rate.

BEETLES and MOTHS: — **FOR GRAIN:** — Mix 1 pint of Malathion Grain Protectant in 1 to 2 gal of water to treat 1,000 bushels. If it goes into storage, **FOR GRAIN:** — Mix 1 pint of Malathion Grain Protectant in 1 to 2 gal of water to treat 1,000 sq. ft. of grain surface established beneath the surface treatment.

BARLEY, OATS, SORGHUM, COTTON SEED: — **BEETLES and MOTHS:** — Mix 10 ozs. Malathion Grain Protectant in 1 to 2 gal of water and spray 1,000 sq. feet.

BEETLES and MOTHS: — Mix 1 pint of Malathion Grain Protectant in 1 to 2 gal of water to treat 1,000 sq. ft. of grain surface established beneath the surface treatment.

BEETLES and MOTHS: — Mix 1 pint of Malathion Grain Protectant in 1 to 2 gal of water to treat 1,000 sq. ft. of grain surface established beneath the surface treatment.

Malathion Grain Protectant upon repeated, prolonged or careless use, may cause cholinesterase inhibition. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid. Atropine is antidotal. Do not use where milk is processed and stored. Remove lactating animals from building before treating. Also remove calves under one month of age before treating.

CAUTION: -- Malathion Grain Protectant may be toxic to certain species of fish. Avoid contamination of lakes, ponds and streams.

CLEAN UP SPILLAGE AND SPRAY WASTE: — Soak up liquid with sawdust or other absorbent materials and bury. Clean up area with strong lye solution.

DISPOSAL OF EMPTY CONTAINERS: — Carefully and completely wash the outside of the empty container with water. Rinse out the inside of the container with water, to which has been added household or commercial detergent and caustic soda (lye). Carefully discard the rinse solution by burying at least 18 inches deep in an isolated area away from water supplies. Fifty-five gallon drums may then be disposed of to any approved drum reconditioner; smaller containers should be broken, mutilated and punctured, after which they may be buried at least 18 inches deep in an isolated area away from water supplies.
