DIRECTIONS for WASHING and SANITIZING UDDERS: (Not recommended as a Teat Dip).

- 1. Add ½ oz. of Surge K.O. Dyne to 10 quarts warm water (not over 110° F.).
- 2. Use fresh towel for each cow to reduce the spread of micro-organisms that may cause mastitis. Soak paper towel in solution. Wash and massage teats and udder. Blot dry.

INFLATION DIP

- 1. Prepare separate solution of ½ oz. Surge K.O. Dyne to 10 quarts wate.
- 2. Dip teat cups in solution before applying to each cow.

BULK TANKS, VATS, BUCKETS AND UTENSILS:

- 1. Immediately after use, flush with tepid water to remove all residual milk.
- 2. Wash all surfaces with recommended Surge Cleaner.
- 3. Sanitize with Surge K.O. Dyne (1 oz. in 5 gals. of water not over 110° F.) by brushing or spraying.

REMOVAL OF MILKSTONE:

Prepare a strong solution using equal parts of Surge K.O. Dyne and warm (110° F.) water. Allow surfaces being cleaned to remain in contact with solution for several minutes, then brush to remove deposit and rinse with slightly warm water. Repeat if necessary. For stubborn deposits use Surge K.O. Dyne full strength.
