Concentrate causes eye damage. Protect eyes when handling. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid skin contact. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

FIRST AID: In case of contact with eyes, flush immediately with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. For skin, wash promptly. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink PROMPTLY a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution. If these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved landfill. Product or rinsate that cannot be used should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Treated effluent may not be discharged into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters without a valid discharge permit. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

STATE AND LOCAL REGULATIONS: Consult your dealer, state or local health authorities for additional information.

KEEP FROM FREEZING: If frozen, separation may occur. Thaw completely and mix well prior to use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a product in a manner inconsistent with **SANITIZING DAIRY EQUIPMENT** sanitize all milk contact surfaces with Dyne as required by state and local Proportions for proper dilution rate. minutes. Drain thoroughly.

UDDER WASHING: Prepare a sanitizing solution (110° F - 43° C). Refer to Table of Proportions for a clean single service towel for each cow. Never dip used towel back into solution. Prepare fresh solution for each milking. Prepare single service towel prior to attachment.

DO NOT USE AS A TEAT DIP

NOTE: Amber to brown color of solution indicates strength. A fresh solution should be prepared in the initial color of solution.
