### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. BABSYNE-20 is used to manufacture sanitizers and disinfectants (germicides). Before sale of any germicide in intra- or interstate commerce, it must be registered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

BABSYNE-20 may be used to manufacture germicides and detergent sanitizers that do not require rinsing if applied to well drained food contact surfaces at concentrations not exceeding 25 ppm titratable iodine (refer to 21 Code of Federal Regulations § 121.2547). To meet this requirement, all components used in finished formulations must also comply with Food & Drug no-rinse regulations.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store only in tightly closed, original containers in a cool, secure area. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Metal:** Triple rinse (or equivalent).
