n-Alkyl (50% C<sub>14</sub>, 40% C<sub>12</sub>, 10% C<sub>10</sub>) dimethyl benzyl ammonium chloride  
Sodium carbonate

**FOR GENERAL CLEANSING:** Use 1 ounce to 2 3 gallons of hot water.

**FOR SANITIZING:** Use 1 ounce to 2 gallons of water for a 200 PPM solution.

DO NOT MIX WITH SOAP OR ANIONIC DETERGENTS.

**CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

Keep out of reach of children. If swallowed, avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Avoid contamination of food.
