STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

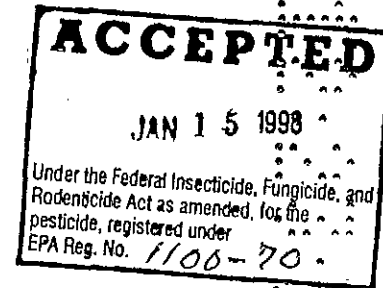

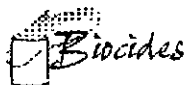
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
