GENERAL USE DESCRIPTION

FUNGITROL Zinc 8% Fungicide is a 60% zinc naphthenate solution containing 8% zinc as metal in exempt mineral spirits. It is designed for manufacturing use only in solvent applications for the formulation of other economic poisons. It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

SOLUBILITY

Insoluble in water; soluble in mineral spirits, xylene, naphtha turpentine, kerosene, mineral oil, toluene, etc.

HAZARDOUS PROPERTIES AND HANDLING

Keep out of reach of children. This product is designed for manufacturing use only. While the product has low toxicity, good hygiene practices should be required of those handling the product.

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FUNGITROL Zinc 8 Fungicide has a low order of acute oral toxicity - LD₅₀ 6000 mg/kg of body weight using rats as the test animals. Avoid eye contact. Prolonged skin contact may cause irritation. Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly after handling. If spilled onto clothing, remove and wash before reuse. Discard contaminated shoes.

Do not contaminate water sources, food or feed by storage or disposal.

In case of spillage, cover with inert absorbent material and remove completely for disposal according to procedures approved by disposal authorities.

Open burning or dumping is prohibited.

FUNGITROL Zinc 8 Fungicide is a combustible liquid. Keep away from heat and open flame. In case of fire, use water spray, foam, CO₂ or dry chemical. Wear self-contained breathing apparatus to fight fire.

Do not use drums for other purposes. Empty the drums completely, flush with hydrocarbon solvent, drain completely and return to drum reconditioner or crush and bury in an approved land fill.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin: Wash immediately with soap and water. Call a physician if irritation develops.

If in Eyes: Flush with water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. Administer artificial respiration or oxygen if necessary. Call a physician.
