PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to humans and domestic animals:
CORROSIVE causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin, or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing dust. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with a gentle steady stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

If swallowed: Call physician or poison control center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with fingers.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water.

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store product in a secure dry place and keep product dry. When opening, closing or handling open packages, or pouring product, wear goggles to keep dust out of eyes. Spilled product should be swept up, used if clean, or disposed of on site and/or waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Store product only in original container. During storage, store pesticides separately to prevent cross contamination of other pesticides, fertilizers, feed or food. When product is to be used as a trace mineral in mixing animal feeds, it may be stored with other trace mineral or feed ingredients.

Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal of this product. Do not reuse container. Completely empty bag, then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if allowed by State and local authorities by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

When product is used as a pesticide, it should be used to manufacture or formulate pesticides or fungicides. This product is not to be used directly as an end-use pesticide.
