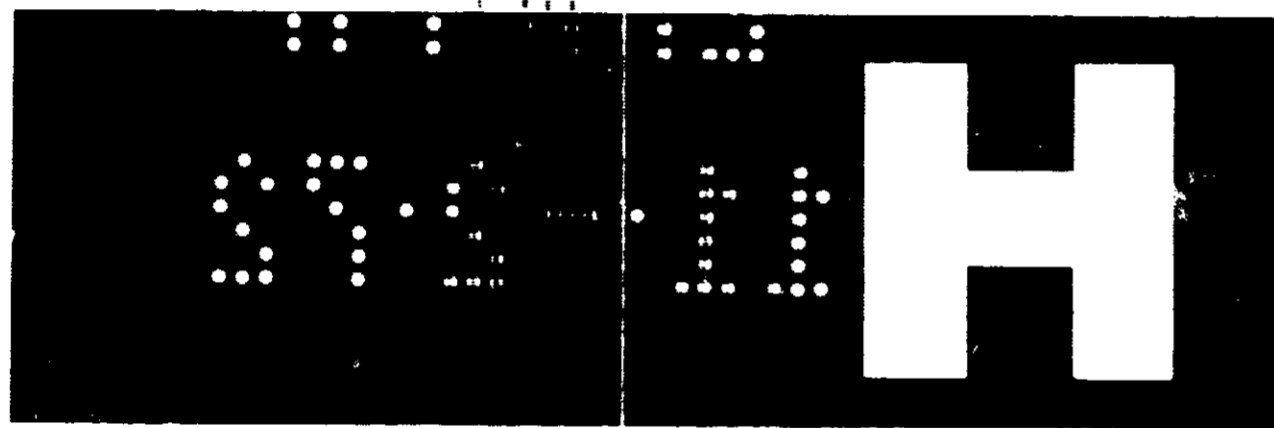

## DANGER!

### KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Avoid contamination of food. **FIRST AID:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes, or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash any contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of fluid and call a physician for treatment.

## DIRECTIONS

1. **Cleaning and Sanitizing Equipment** in meat packing plants: Mop, swab or spray a solution of 1 oz. HOSPITAL SAN-O-SIX per gallon of water onto surface. Allow 10 minutes contact time. Rinse thoroughly with potable water.
2. **Heavily Soiled Surfaces:** Follow same procedure in part (1) except use a solution of 2 oz. HOSPITAL SAN-O-SIX per gallon of warm water. Use agitation where possible.
3. **Used at 2 oz. per gallon.** HOSPITAL SAN-O-SIX will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* (PRD-10). Mop or swab this solution onto surface. Allow 10 minutes contact time. Rinse thoroughly with potable water.
4. **To disinfect Athlete's Foot fungi** on environmental surfaces: Prepare a solution of 1 oz. HOSPITAL SAN-O-SIX per gallon of water. Mop or spray this onto floors and other surfaces normally contacted by the feet in locker rooms, showers, and around swimming pools.
5. **Food equipment or other food contact items:** Use 1/2 oz. HOSPITAL SAN-O-SIX per gallon of water. Mop, wipe or spray solution on equipment. Do not rinse.  
**RINSE EMPTY CONTAINER THOROUGHLY AND DISCARD.**
