# ENGO\*

For the Control of Ticks, Lice, Fleas and  
Sarcoptic Mange Mites of Dogs

**Active Ingredients:**

- Technical Chlordane\*\* ..... 40% w/w
  - Pine Oil ..... 10% w/w
  - Petroleum Solvent ..... 38% w/w
  - Inert Ingredients: ..... 12% w/w
- \*\*Equivalent to 24% octachloro-4, 7-methanotetrahydroindane and 16% of related compounds.

**DIRECTIONS**

Add 3 tablespoonfuls of Engo to 1 gallon water. Animal should first be bathed with soap and water, then rinsed and toweled. Then apply diluted solution with sponge or cloth or by dipping, and allow animal to dry without toweling.

**TO PREVENT REINFESTATION, REPEAT APPLICATION EVERY 2 TO 3 WEEKS.**

**CAUTION:** Keep out of the reach of children. Use only diluted solution as indicated. Contact with skin of undiluted or prolonged contact with the diluted product can cause toxic symptoms. In case of spillage on skin, wash immediately with soap and water. Avoid inhalation and contamination of feed and food stuffs. For external use only. Harmful if swallowed.
