General Directions for Disinfection

After thorough washing, rinse the containers or utensils in a solution made by adding I tablespoonful of Nolvasan to each gallon of clean water. The cap of this bottle may be used for measuring. I capful being sufficient for each gallon of water.

For aiding in the control of virus diseases, such as infectious bronchitis or canine distemper - clean the walls, cages or utensils thoroughly and spray the surfaces with a diluted Nolvasan solution by adding 1 or 2 table-spoonfuls, or capfuls, to each gallon of clean water.

Cloths used for udder cleansing should remain in the disinfectant solution for 2 minutes before applying. This will aid in the control of mastitis.

Caution: Nolvasan in its concentrated form may be irritating to eyes, skin or nucous membranes. Wash exposed tissues thoroughly. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs.
