The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, as per our telephone conversation on June 14th, 2000, to request stamped labeling, is acceptable provided that you make the following revisions:

A. Revise the "Precautionary Statements" to read as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Danger. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Wear protective eyewear(Goggles, faceshield, or safety glasses). Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin or inhaled. Maybe fatal if inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or clothing and do not swallow. Wear rubber gloves when handling or applying.

B. Revise the "Environmental Hazards" section as per PR Notice 83-3.

DANGER

Corrosive: Causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes. Wear protective eyewear (Goggles, tace shield or safety glasses.) May be fatal if inhaled: Do not breathe spray mist or fogging mist.

Avoid contact with skin or clothing and do not swallow. Wear rubber gloves when handling or applying.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention. If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air, if not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical

If swallowed; Call a physician or Poison Control Center, Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomitting by touching back of throat with finger. # person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting. If on skin: Wash with blenty of soap and water, Get medical attention if imitation observed,

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
