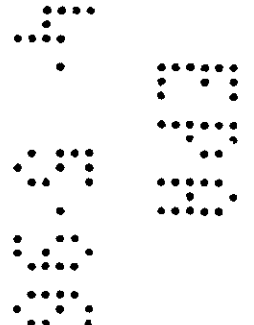

For formulation into an antimicrobial product for use as a hard-surface disinfectant for indoor use (a use for which U.S. EPA has accepted the required data).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store at controlled room temperature 15°C - 30°C

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instruction, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

TO DISPOSE OF CONTAINER (fiber drum with liner): Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment.
