<b>LABORING</b> - For washing mopheads, automobile engines or the floor. Bleach solution will remove dirt, grease, oil, and grime. Use on painted surfaces, but not on chrome, brass, or silver. (Dilute with water.)	1 qt. or 1/2 cup of Bleach to each 2 gallons of water. Use on painted surfaces, but not on chrome, brass, or silver. (Dilute with water.)	Add Bleach to water or keep water. Rinse well. If Bleach cannot be added before clothes are in machine, dilute recommended amount in one quart of water before using.
<b>TO WHITER YELLOWED OR GREYED KITCHEN, BATHROOM, OR OLEONE</b>	Use 2 tablespoons or 1/2 cup Bleach to one gallon hot water.	Remove stain. Rinse. If stain is not removed, repeat. If needed.
<b>REMOVE SCORCH &amp; STAIN</b> - Burn on hair, on apron, and coffee, tea, chocolate, grease, etc. Also remove.	One part Bleach to 20 parts water or 1/2 cup Bleach per quart of water.	Soak item 5 to 10 minutes in Bleach solution. Rinse well.
<b>CLEANING KITCHEN &amp; BATHROOM</b> - Bleach is excellent for cleaning tile, porcelain, enameled, brass, & tubs.	2 tablespoons or 1/2 cup Bleach in quart of cold water.	Scrub with cloth moistened with cold water. Let stand 2 minutes. Rinse well.
<b>FOR EMERGENCY DRINKING WATER</b>	Use 10 drops of Bleach to each gallon of water.	Let stand 5 to 10 minutes before drinking.
<b>GENERAL DISINFECTING USES</b> - In Hospitals, Schools, Stores, Camps, Hotels, etc.	1 qt. or 1/2 cup of Bleach per 2 gallons of cold water.	Use in a recommended amount disinfecting solution by using 2 parts Bleach to 100 parts water. BLEACH SOLUTION FOR PPM AVAILABLE ONLY.
<b>SPECIAL DISINFECTING USES</b> - In Hospitals, Stores, Hotels, Camps, etc.	3 tablespoons of Bleach to each quart of cold or lukewarm water.	First wash in cold water. Immerse in Bleach solution 5 minutes. Rinse well.
<b>REFRIGERATORS</b>	3 tablespoons of Bleach to each quart of warm water.	Thoroughly wash inside surface and shelves. Keep wet 5 minutes with Bleach solution. Rinse well with warm water. Air dry.
<b>Washing Machine</b> - To insure white and refreshen colors, add 1/2 cup Bleach to each load of laundry. (Do not use on silk, wool, or rayon.)	1/2 qt. or 1/2 cup Bleach to each 1000 gallons of warm water.	Thoroughly wet. Bleach 20 parts water and use solution through a cloth. Rinse well with warm water. Rinse well with solution. Spin and dry.
<b>SICK ROOM, URINALS, BEDPANS, SPORTING CUPS, ETC.</b>	3 tablespoons of Bleach per quart of hot water.	Wash thoroughly with warm water. Rinse. Follow with solution. Spin and dry.
<b>DAILY AND FARM EQUIPMENT</b> - Milk separators, pots, milking machines, etc. Use 1/2 cup Bleach per 2 gallons of cold water.	1 qt. or 1/2 cup Bleach per 2 gallons of cold water.	Wash thoroughly with warm water. Rinse. Follow with solution. Spin and dry.
<b>TOILET BOWL'S, URINAL PIPES</b>	1 qt. or 1/2 cup Bleach per 2 gallons of cold water.	Will not harm plumbing or ceramic pipes. Do not use with other brands of toilet bowl or urinal cleaning agents.
